

IFTTT enables users to create and share "Recipes" that fit the statement: "if this then that". [1] The "this" part of a Recipe is called a Trigger. Some example Triggers are "I'm tagged in a photo on Facebook" or "I check in on Foursquare". The "that" part of a Recipe is called an Action. Some example Actions are "send me a text message" or "create a status message on Facebook". The combination of a Trigger and an Action from a user's active channels are called Recipes. [4] The service offers Triggers and Actions for 121 channels, [5] such as Twitter, Foursquare, Flickr, and Box. [6] In June 2012, the service entered the Internet of Things space by integrating with Belkin WeMo devices, [7] allowing Recipes to interact with the physical world. By combining IFTTT with other services such as Yahoo! Pipes, one can build elaborate systems that enable easier consumption of content from a variety of sources.




Social Accounts

Social media is a huge time suck if you let it be. A lot of the recipes below can really speed up your social network interactions.


1. Easily change your profile pictures. When you change your Facebook, your Twitter profile picture updates automatically.




2. When you are tagged in a photo on Facebook, the image is sent to your Dropbox. https://ifttt.com/recipes/1760

5. Easily add YouTube videos you mark as Watch Later to Evernote. https://ifttt.com/recipes/80233




6. The same thing as recipe above but it adds the YouTube videos you favorite to Journal in Evernote – https://ifttt.com/recipes/80969




7. Adds anything starred in Google Reader to a note in Evernote for later reading or keeping track of interesting articles




Weather

Automating any important weather updates will make a life a lot easier. Some of the recipes below will let you know when the weather changes, automatically track when it rains and more.

10. Receive a text message when the weather changes. While the default is set to notify you of rain, you can change the trigger to use rain, snow, cloudy or clear. – https://ifttt.com/recipes/48


12. Receive a text message from the NOAA Severe Weather service when there is bad weather near you. – https://ifttt.com/recipes/23025


28. Now all your orders at one place! This will create PDF of the receipts in your Gmail and save to Dropbox
