7. Pollution Under Control (PUC) Certification

5. The vehicle will undergo a physical inspection by RTO officials.

Road Tax Details in Mangalore (KA19)

Road tax in Mangalore is determined based on several factors like vehicle cost, age, fuel type, and category. Below is a general breakdown:

For Two-Wheelers:

- Below ₹50,000 – 10% of vehicle cost
- ₹50,000 to ₹1,00,000 – 12% of vehicle cost
- Above ₹1,00,000 – 18% of vehicle cost

For Four-Wheelers:

- Below ₹5 lakh – 13% of vehicle cost
- ₹5 lakh to ₹10 lakh – 14% of vehicle cost
- ₹10 lakh to ₹20 lakh – 17% of vehicle cost
- Above ₹20 lakh – 18% of vehicle cost

Commercial Vehicles:

Road tax depends on vehicle weight, seating capacity, and usage type (goods or passenger transport).
