

Differences between red teaming and penetration testing





DIFFERENCES BETWEEN RED TEAMING AND PENETRATION TESTING

More often than not, the above terms are used interchangeably. With a cursory glance, this usage may be completely fine, but a closer look reveals several differences between the two.

RED TEAMING

A longer time duration and is tested concurrently

Employees are not aware of the attack

A wide target area and looks into known and unknown vulnerabilities

PENETRATION TESTING

A shorter time duration and is tested independently

Employees may be aware of the attack

A narrowly defined target area and looks into known vulnerabilities
