

Goa 10th Results 2016

The CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) class 12th results 2015 were announced on May 25, 2015 (Monday) in addition to being has been this look for many years now, girls have outperformed boys, with the pass percentage and also in the top position, that has been secured by Delhi girl M Gayatri.

Where M Gayatri of New Green Field school, Saket topped CBSE class 12 class board exams for that academic year 2014-15 with 496 beyond 500 marks, the 2nd rank continues to be shared by three students – Mythili Mishra (Noida), B Arun (Trivendram) and Saurabh Bhambri (Delhi), every one of whom scored 495 marks.

Talking over the telephone with FinancialExpress.com, topper Gayatri says she hasn't checked her Goa 10th result 2016 result yet but is continuously getting calls from her teachers and friends. "I am delighted," she exclaimed.

Gayatri's score card read English Core 98, Economics 98, Mathematics 100, Business Studies 100 and Accountancy 100.

The third rank is shared by three students Poonam Kumari from Mohindergarh (Haryana), Gurwinder Singh Saini from Jalandhar and N Nishok Kumar from Chennai, who obtained 494 away from 500 marks.

In 2014, a Delhi Public School in Vasant Kunj student, Sarthak Aggarwal had topped the CBSE 12th Result 2015. Sarthak was inside Science stream and squeezed 99.6 per-cent marks.

While overall pass amount of 2015 is 82.00, pass area of girls is 87.55 knowning that for boys is 77.77.

Region-wise, Thiruvananthapuram has scored the greatest overall pass percentage with 95.41.

A total of 13,284 students in foreign countries had also appeared from the class XII examination and pass percentage is 92.31.

Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) class 12th result was declared on Monday afternoon on its website cbseresults.nic.in around 12.30 following the websites crashed repeatedly. The board, however, got official earlier within the morning that they're going to be announcing 12th board result today i.e. on May 25, 2015 and 10th board result on Wednesday, i.e. May 27, 2015.

- 3) Click 'submit'
- 4) Take a list: Students should save a duplicate of their result for future reference.

CBSE is likewise uploading merit list later within the day on its official website cbseresults.nic.in and cbse.nic.in.

This year a complete of 10,40,368 appeared for your <u>Maharashtra 10th result 2016</u>. Gender break-up shows about 6,07,383 boys and 4,32,985 girls appeared with the examinations – a comprehensive increase of a.01 per-cent.

Central Board of Secondary Education post-result counselling would begin from today itself and continue till June 8 from 8 am to 10 pm, that it has provided a toll-free number — 1800118004.

Photocopies with the evaluated answer sheets will probably be provided to the candidate(s) requesting for this and only to prospects candidates who may have applied for verification of

marks. Board is going to be accepting applications from June 13 to June 17.

It also said the few candidates who make application for verification of marks as well as for obtaining photocopy on the evaluated answer book can sign up for re-evaluation in maximum 10 questions each.

The re-evaluation of answer books are going to be available for subjects including English Core, English Elective(NCERT), English Elective(CBSE), Hindi Core, Hindi Elective, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Business Studies, Economics and Accountancy.
