

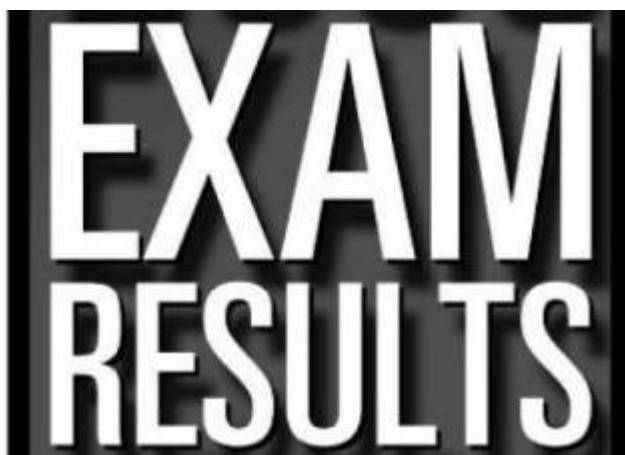


CBSE issues guidelines to schools

CHANDIGARH: CBSE has asked schools to sing the national anthem in proper manner and sing becoming stated inside constitution of India. Board has given guidelines on the way to sing the anthem including time duration the place that the national anthem is usually to be sung.

In a recently available circular the Central Board of Secondary Education stated that " in their framework from the values education lists the Article 51(A) with the Indian Constitution- Fundamental Duties which contains 10 principles along with the first an example may be "to stick to the constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the national flag along with the national anthem. The board has framed four behavioral descriptors for [MP Board 12th Result 2016](#) college students for this principle. The second descriptor entails singing of national anthem with decorum."

In another link within the circular the board has considering the wordings in the full version in the anthem as well as its playing time that's approximately 52 seconds. "A short version consisting in the first and last lines on the national anthem can also be played on certain occasions," it stated.



Playing time with the short version is concerning 20 seconds. Board has further defined occasions on what the full versions or even the short version are going to be played.

The full version from the anthem should be played about the following [Rajasthan Board 12th Result](#) occasions including "civil and military investitures, national salute, during parades, on arrival in the President at formal state functions, When the national flag is induced parade, in the event the regimental shirt is presented etc.

The full version in the anthem have to be played together with mass singing within the unfurling on the national flag, on cultural occasions or ceremonial functions besides parades additionally, on arrival from the President at any government or public function, the instructions read.

In all schools, the day's work can start with community singing from the anthem. School authorities should make adequate provision within their programmes for popularizing the singing in the anthem and promoting respect with the national flag among students.
