Materials containing asbestos within the bathroom will tend to be seen on floors, walls and fittings. It provides for a compound that's put into a glue to bind vinyl tiles and earn vinyl wallpaper. Section of the material has also been accustomed to make baths. Asbestos was widely used in the bathroom because of its water resistant property.

Safe Work Australia recommends an inspection be completed first to look for the type of asbestos present, before proceeding with removal. After inspection, the removal process can start. This task must be completed by a licensed contractor.

Make sure that you work with a contractor who follows each of the precautionary measures that apply in removal of asbestos. For example, wearing protective gear to lessen the likelihood of being received by direct connection with asbestos and limiting access to the area being worked on should be priorities.

Several methods for you to use to take out asbestos from a bathroom:

1. Water Injection and Saturation

Within this method, very thick asbestos is fully soaked in water. The restroom floor will probably have such thick asbestos. Water is injected into the asbestos by usage of an exclusive injecting head containing inlets and outlets for water. The injectors are later disposed of as asbestos waste, because of their direct experience of the dangerous substance.

2. Dry Removal Method

This technique is applied when working in a bathroom with live wires and good conductors of electricity. That is designed to avoid accidents like electric shocks. The process may also be applied when in areas which might be enclosed fully or partially.

3. Wet Removal Method

Using this method is extremely favoured by most asbestos removal contractors as it cuts down on chances of fibres getting airborne. Minimal or no dust is guaranteed since the water used is under low pressure. Here, the fibres are suppressed by pouring water over them under minimal pressure. A detergent may be put into the lake to boost absorption rates. The restroom surface should remain wet through the process. This kind of method enables you to remove bathroom asbestos tiles.

Be keen to identify asbestos within your bathroom given it could be found on the beautiful tiles, wallpaper and ceiling. You definitely don't wish to discover this kind of harmful substance if it's already too far gone.
